SEPTEMBER 12, 2003 -- The Denver Botanic Gardens has rolled out its most daunting labyrinth yet at Chatfield Nature Preserve. This year's fourth annual giant, five-acre Corn Maze features the intricate design of the polar bear logo for the Scientific, Cultural and Facilities District (SCFD). The convoluted pathways and surprising dead-ends are a challenge for even the most experienced maze-goers.

Admission for the maze is \$8 for adults; \$7 for adult members, adults over 65, and students with I.D.; \$6 for children ages 3-15, and \$5 for children members. The maze will be open until October 31 on Fridays (4 p.m. to 10 p.m.), Saturdays (10 a.m. to 10 p.m.) and Sundays (Noon to 8 p.m.). Last tickets are sold one hour before closing each night.

\$5 for member kids

The Botanic Gardens chose the logo as this year's design to honor and [celebrate 15 years](#) of cultural funding made possible through the SCFD tax measure that was first passed by Denver metro voters in 1988.

From Wadsworth, take a right (west) onto Deer Creek Canyon Road. Chatfield Nature Preserve is one-half mile up on the left.
