SEPTEMBER 12, 2003 -- The Denver Botanic Gardens has rolled out its most daunting labyrinth yet at Chatfield Nature Preserve. This year's fourth annual giant, five-acre Corn Maze features the intricate design of the polar bear logo for the Scientific, Cultural and

Facilities District (SCFD). The convoluted pathways and surprising dead-ends are a challenge for even the most experienced maze-goers.

Admission for the maze is \$8 for adults; \$7 for adult members, adults over 65, and students with I.D.; \$6 for children ages 3-15, and \$5 for children members. The maze will be open until October 31 on Fridays (4 p.m. to 10 p.m.), Saturdays (10 a.m. to 10 p.m.) and Sundays (Noon to 8 p.m.). Last tickets are sold one hour before closing each night.

The Botanic Gardens chose the logo as this year's design to honor and <u>celebrate</u> 15 years of cultural funding made possible through the SCFD tax measure that was first passed by Denver metro voters in 1988.

The sales and use tax of one penny on every ten-dollar purchase generates more than \$30 million annually and helps fund over 300 organizations in the seven counties that comprise the

district: Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas and Jefferson.

Chatfield Nature Preserve is located at 8500 Deer Creek Canyon Road in Littleton. To get there, take I-25 south to C-470 west and exit south on Wadsworth Boulevard. From Wadsworth, take a right (west) onto Deer Creek Canyon Road. Chatfield Nature Preserve is one-half mile up on the left.
